

# AMERICAN EMBASSY

## HOW TO GET THERE

### From Yokosuka Chuo:

1. Go to YOKOSUKA CHUO 横須賀中央 Station and buy a ¥860 transfer ticket for SHIMBASHI 新橋, which is on the TOEI ASAKUSA Line (subway) 都営浅草線 in Tokyo.
2. Take a GREEN or RED KANJI train bound for SHINAGAWA 品川 from track #2.  
**Note:** If you take a GREEN KANJI train ( Exit at SHINAGAWA Station but stay on that platform. Take any of the next train to SHIMBASHI Station. If you take a RED KANJI train ( Keep riding on RED train until you reach SHIMBASHI Station.
3. Get off at SHINAGAWA Station.
4. Get off at SHIMBASHI 新橋 Station, go through the wicket (turn in your ticket here) and follow the bilingual transfer signs to the GINZA Line (subway) 銀座線. It is located across the station. You will have to walk up one flight of stairs and then down a short flight.
5. Take the GINZA 銀座線 Line, buy a ¥160 ticket, then go through the wicket to track #1 bound for SHIBUYA 渋谷.
6. Get off at TAMEIKE-SANNO 溜池山王 station, 2<sup>nd</sup> stop from Shimbashi. Use escalators/stairs located at the center of the platform to go to the ticket wicket downstairs.
7. After leaving the ticket wicket, turn to the left for Exit No. 13. You will have about a 7 to 8 minute walk before you encounter an exit sign leading you to the street.
8. When you come out to the sidewalk level you immediately turn around and walk to the corner where you will see a PRONTO coffee shop and BERLITZ English language school. Turn right at the corner and walk to the next corner at which time you will come across the American Embassy.

### From Ikego:

1. Go to JIMMUJI 神武寺 Station and buy a ¥790 transfer ticket for SHIMBASHI 新橋, which is on the TOEI ASAKUSA 都営浅草線 (subway) Line.
  2. Take a train from Track #2 to KANAZAWA BUNKO 金沢文庫 and change to a GREEN or RED KANJI train bound for SHINAGAWA.
  3. **Continue as above #3.**
- ▶**Note:** During certain time of the day it may be necessary to switch trains at KANAZAWA KAKKEI 金沢八景.

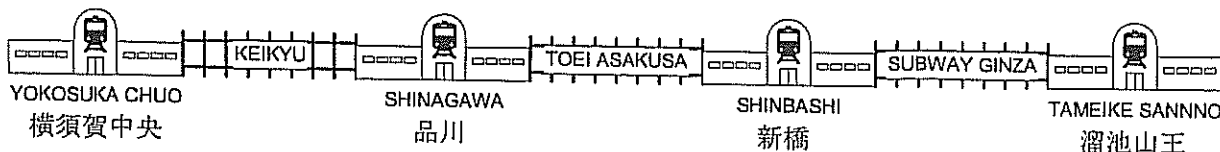
## RETURN

### To Yokosuka:

1. Buy a ¥160 ticket and take the GINZA Line (orange) on track #2 at TAMEIKE-SANNO Station.
2. Get off at SHIMBASHI Station, go through the wicket and give up the ticket.
3. Next, follow the sign for TOEI-ASAKUSA line (pink). It will be quite a long walk before reaching the entrance to TOEI-ASAKUSA Line.
4. Go to any of the ticket machine and buy a ¥860 transfer ticket for YOKOSUKA CHUO (¥790 for JIMMUJI) on KEIKYU Line 京急線 (Select the button for "English" instructions).
5. Go to track #1 for the train bound for SHINAGAWA. **Wait for a RED KANJI train.** The final destination for this train will be MISAKIGUCHI 三崎口. YOKOSUKA CHUO will be the 12<sup>th</sup> stop past SHINAGAWA.

### To Ikego

1. Follow as above #1 ~ #5 direction up to KANAZAWA BUNKO 金沢文庫 (or Kanazawa Hakkei 金沢八景) Station.
2. Get off at KANAZAWA BUNKO (or Kanazawa Hakkei) Station and change train bound for SHIN-ZUSHI 新逗子.

### + HOW TO GET THERE

#### From Yokosuka Chuo:

1. Go to YOKOSUKA CHUO 横須賀中央 Station and purchase a ¥770 transfer ticket for EBISU 恵比寿, which is on JR YAMANOTE JR 山手線 Line in Tokyo. For a child's ticket ¥390.
2. Go to track #2 and board a GREEN or RED KANJI train bound for SHINAGAWA 品川.
3. At SHINAGAWA, transfer to JR YAMANOTE Line. Insert your ticket into the automatic wicket (or show to the clerk) as you pass through the gate leading to JR lines (bilingual signs show the way), but do not give it up, it will come back up from the wicket. Go up or down the stairs to track #2 and take JR YAMANOTE line train 4 stops to EBISU.
4. At EBISU, exit out from West Exit 西口. Turn in your ticket as you pass through the exit wicket. You will not get your ticket back.
5. The subway entrance is located just outside EBISU station (West exit), to the right. Take HIBIYA 日比谷線 Subway Line. Purchase the lowest price subway ticket and ride one stop to HIROO 広尾. At HIROO, get off train and take Exit 1. Exit left, then down the street to the large overpass crosswalk. Make a left, the New Sanno is on the left around the bend from the overpass crosswalk. It is a large (approx. 4 floors) dark brown building).

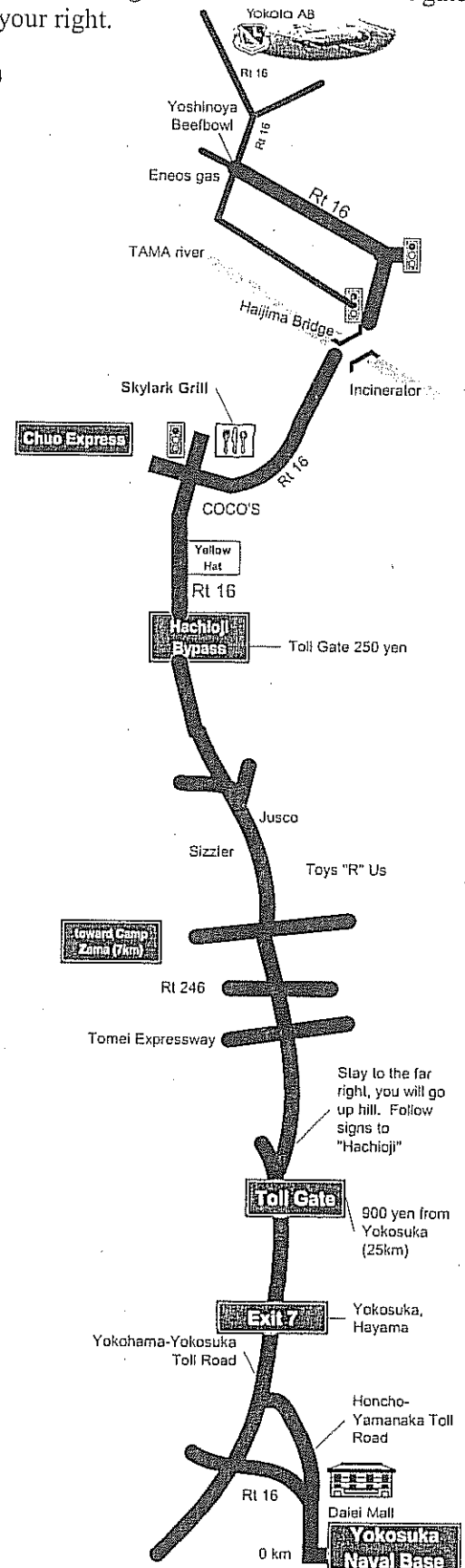

**Driving direction:**

1. Turn right at the main gate onto Rt. 16 and stay in right lane after Daiei Mall.
2. Take HONCHO-YAMANAKA Toll Rd. Pay ¥200 at tollgate and then go left at the fork to YOKOSUKA-YOKOHAMA Toll Rd.
3. Take YOKO-YOKO Rd. toward YOKOHAMA to the end and pay ¥900 (¥800 from Zushi).
4. Continue straight on Rt.16 following the signs for HACHIOJI. The road is well marked, be sure to follow the signs that direct you to stay on Rt. 16 and go toward HACHIOJI.
5. Continue on Rt.16 to the HACHIOJI-BYPASS. Pay ¥250 at the tollgate, and then proceed on the Bypass.
6. Stay in right lane on the Bypass road until it merges with local Rt. 16 where has signs for CHUO EXPWY to the right and KEN-O EXPWY to the left.
7. Turn right at COCO'S Restaurants on your right onto local Rt.16.
8. After the right go across Tama River and be prepared to make a left turn to follow Rt.16.
9. Stay in left lanes until Rt.16 turns to the left. Go into right lane and make right turn at YOSHINOYA Beef bowl (orange sign), ENEOS gas station on left.
10. Take left fork to continue on Rt.16. You will begin to see Base housing off to your right. You are now driving along side Yokota Base. You

can enter through Fussa gate or the Main gate on your right.

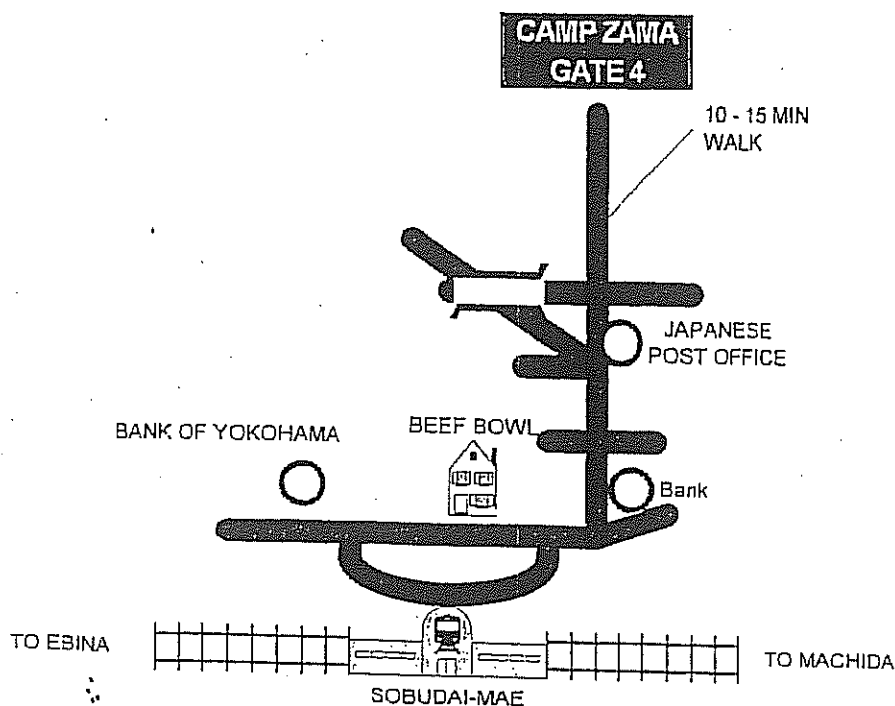
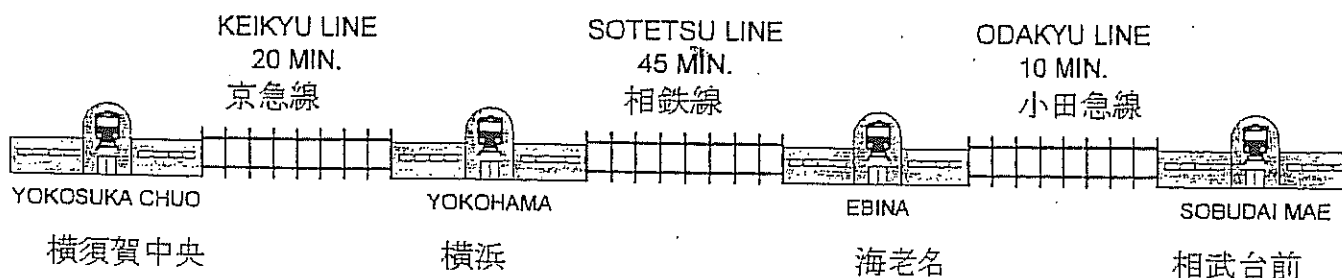
# ZAMA BY TRAIN

## From Yokosuka Chuo:

1. Go to YOKOSUKA CHUO横須賀中央 Station and buy a ¥650 transfer ticket for EBINA海老名 Station on SOTETSU相鉄線 Line. This ticket is for your entire trip so keep it until you reach EBINA海老名.
2. Go to track #2 at YOKOSUKA CHUO横須賀中央 Station and take a GREEN or RED KANJI train to YOKOHAMA横浜.
3. When you get off the train at YOKOHAMA横浜, turn right. You'll find the stairs down to SOTETSU相鉄線 Line (sign in English) at the end of the platform. Go down the stairs and walk through the hall.
4. Show your ticket, proceed through the wickets, and go to track #2 or #3. Look for the express train indicated by white kanji on a red background or RED kanji on a white background.
5. Take this express to EBINA海老名.
6. Go out the wicket and up the stairs. Turn right and go up another flight of stairs to find ODAKYU小田急 Line.
7. Buy a ticket for ¥150 and proceed to track #3 or #4, and take any train (except the RED Kanji) to SOBUDAI-MAE相武台前, two stops from EBINA海老名.

## From Ikego:

1. Go to JIMMUJI神武寺 Station and buy a ¥600 transfer ticket for EBINA海老名 Station on SOTETSU相鉄線 Line. This ticket is for your entire trip so keep it until you reach EBINA海老名.
2. Take a train from track #2 to KANAZAWA BUNKO金沢文庫 and change train to a GREEN or RED KANJI train to YOKOHAMA.
3. Continue as above # 3.



# ATSUGI & ZAMA BY DRIVING

## **TO ATSUGI** (Naval Air Facility)

### From Yokosuka or Ikego:

Go to YOKOHAMA-YOKOSUKA (YOKO-YOKO) Toll Road toward YOKOHAMA. Pay ¥900 (¥800 from Zushi) at the tollgate then take the HODOGAYA BYPASS toward HACHIOJI (Rt. 16). You can either take the SHIMOKAWAI EXIT and go to the back gate or take Rt. 246 to go to the front gate.

**SHIMOKAWAI EXIT** - Go left at the intersection on Rt. 45. Proceed straight until you see a blue sign (7th light including the light at Shimokawai). Use the right lane to turn right towards Yamato. This road Rt. 40 will take you to the back gate (East Gate) of Atsugi base. The back gate (East Gate) is open 24 hours.

**RT. 16 & RT. 246** - Follow Hodogaya Bypass that connects to Rt. 16. You will pass through a trestle bridge and over the entrance/exit of Tomei Expressway until you see a blue sign. Stay in the left lane and turn left onto Rt. 246. On Rt. 246, you will pass through a tunnel. Count the traffic light after the tunnel by Red Lobster as 1. At the 3rd light, (where you see a pachinko parlor with a large parking lot on your right) turn left. Go straight until you cross a railroad track and come to a "T". Turn right at the "T", and at the next intersection (Sagamino Pachinko with big Gorilla), turn left. After about 1km, there is a stoplight at a "Y" intersection. Stay to the left, and this road will take you to the front gate.

## **TO CAMP ZAMA** (Army Base)

### From Yokosuka or Ikego:

Go to the YOKO-YOKO Toll Road toward YOKOHAMA. Pay ¥900 (¥800 from Zushi) at the tollgate then take the HODOGAYA BYPASS toward HACHIOJI (Rt. 16).

**RT. 16 & RT. 51** - Stay on Rt. 16 (passing Shimokawai Exit, entrance to Tomei Expressway and intersection of Rt. 246). Take a left onto Rt. 51 and follow this road all the way to Camp Zama. (There will be numerous traffic lights). You are almost there when you pass under an off-ramp and on your left is an orange colored statue in front of a large fire station. You will enter Camp Zama at the gate on your right. You passed Camp Zama if you go through a short tunnel.

**RT. 16 & RT. 246** - Proceed on Rt. 16. Turn left onto Rt. 246. Follow Rt. 246 and make a right on Rt. 42. **Stay right** when you approach the "Y" where the Stork Gas station is located. You will pass a school, then 2 huge brown buildings (Zama City Hall) and another school (junior high), all on your right but located in different blocks. Turn left immediately at the intersection adjacent to the Junior High School. This narrow road will connect to Rt. 51 where you will take a left (bottom of hill) and you will enter Camp Zama on your right.

**SHIMOKAWAI EXIT** - If traffic has built up on Hodogaya Bypass, exit on Shimokawai and proceed as you would to go to the back gate of NAF Atsugi. Enter there and exit through the main gate. Follow the road to the "T" (Sagamino Pachinko) and turn left. Proceed to the next major intersection (traffic light) and turn right. Follow the road until you come to another "T", Rt. 42. Turn right and follow the directions for above Rt. 16 & Rt. 246, starting from "**Stay right.**"

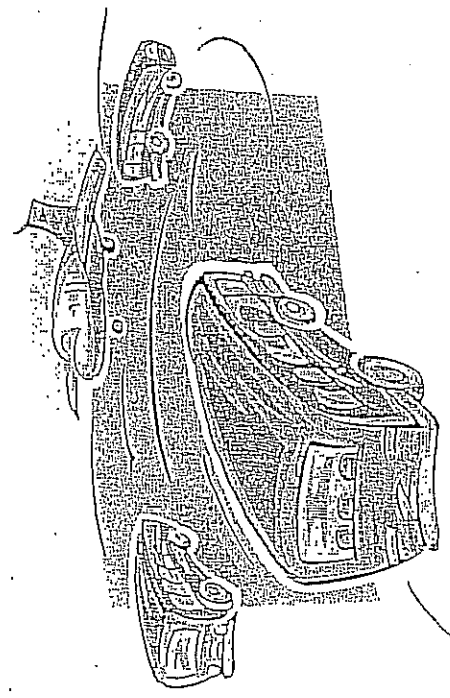

# *NARITA AIRPORT BY TRAIN*

For people living in Yokosuka, Yokohama or Ikego the easiest and cheapest (FREE) way to get to and from Narita International Airport is to take the CFAY Narita Bus. For reservations and bus schedules for departing or arriving buses, inquire at the Narita/Yokota Bus Sign-up Desk, located on the first deck of Bldg.1555, or call 243-7777. Personnel traveling on PCS or TAD orders have priority on seats available. Buses depart from, and arrive at, PSD, Bldg. 1555. For the location of the bus from Narita back to Yokosuka please pick-up a map at the customer service desk outside of customs at the Terminal 1.

## **JR TRAIN (EASIER) From JR Yokosuka Station**

1. Go to JR YOKOSUKA Station and buy a ¥2520 ticket for NARITA AIRPORT.

**NOTE 1:** Without baggage, it is a 15 minute walk from the main gate, right out of the gate, past Daiei and the park, staying on the right side of the road. With baggage, take a cab, asking for JR Yokosuka Eki, or go across Rt. 16 in front of the gate and take any bus except # 31, 32, 33 to JR Yokosuka station.

2. Take the train heading for TOKYO. The ride to Narita Airport takes about 3 hours.

**NOTE 2:** Some trains require a transfer at Zushi or other stations, since they don't go as far as Narita. Direct trains have a sign "NARITA AIRPORT" in English.

**NOTE 3:** The first stop at Narita is Terminal 2. The second stop is Terminal 1.

## **JR TRAIN From JR Zushi Station**

1. Go to JR ZUSHI Station and buy a ¥2210 ticket for NARITA AIRPORT.

2. **Continue with #2 above.**

**NOTE 1:** From IKEGO Housing, go to JIMMUJI Station (KEIKYU Line) to SHIN ZUSHI Station, and then walk about 5 minutes to JR Zushi Station. If you are driving to JR Zushi Station, take a right at 7-11 store (Rt. 24) go straight down and you'll find the JR Station.

## **RETURN:**

### **For Yokosuka**

1. When you get to the arrival Lobby, take the escalator to the basement level B1 where you will come to JR Narita Airport Station. Follow the bilingual signs until you come to the green and white "JR Line" sign and ticket machines.
2. Buy a ¥2520 ticket for JR YOKOSUKA. Check the bilingual electronic departure time sign near the gate for the next departure and take a train bound for Tokyo, Zushi, or Kurihama. The trains listed on the chart below are called "RAPID AIRPORT NARITA," on the departure time sign at the station. Some trains will require a transfer at either Tokyo or Zushi Station (see the attached timetable). The trip will take about 3 hours. Since you will be boarding the train at the beginning of the run, you should be able to get a seat.
3. Get off at YOKOSUKA Station. Once you get outside the JR Yokosuka Station, take either a taxi or bus #1 (second bus stop) to the base.

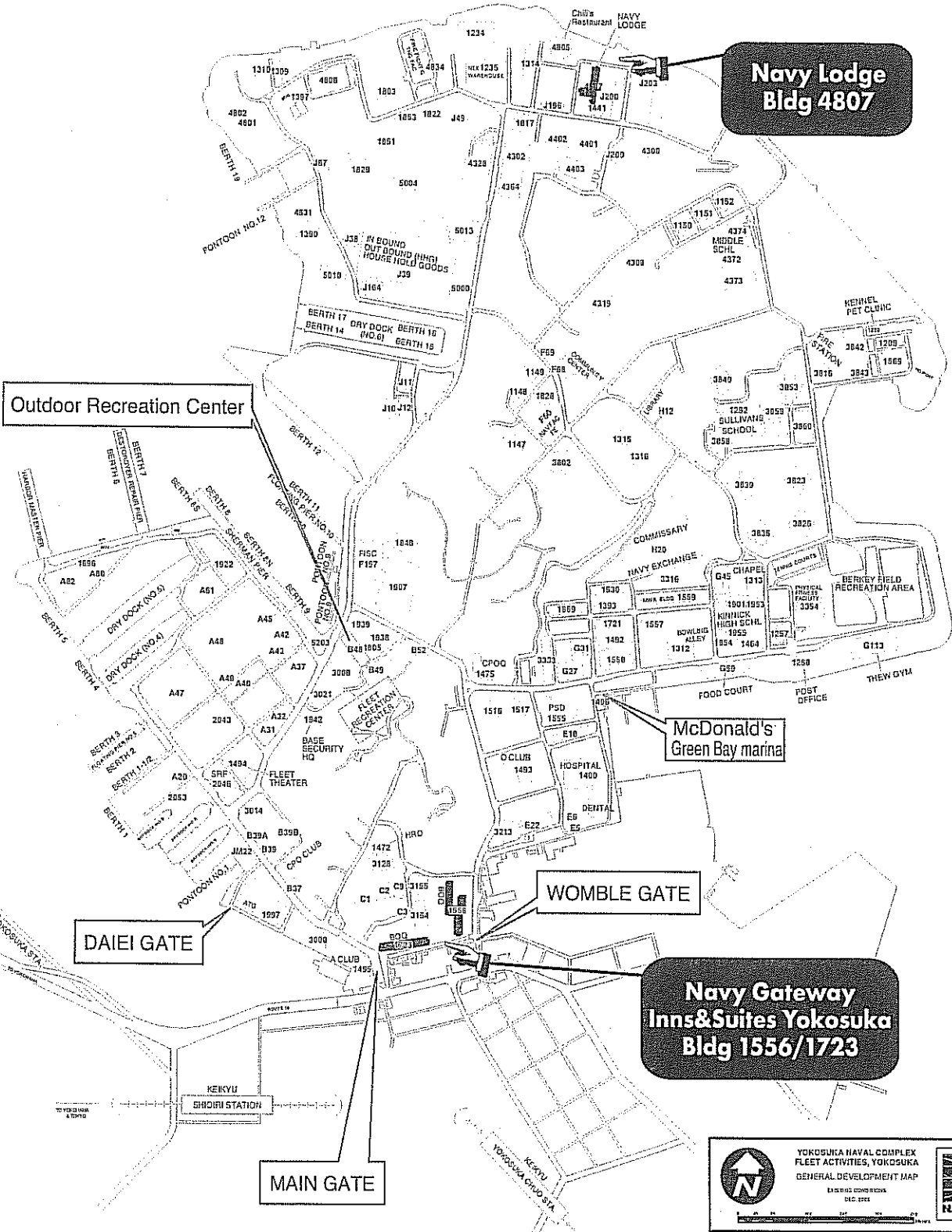
### **For Ikego**



1. **Follow with #1~2 above.**
2. Buy a ¥ 2210 ticket for JR ZUSHI.
3. Get off at Zushi Station. Once you get outside the JR Zushi Station, take either taxi or walk to Shin Zushi Station (Keikyu Line), about 5 minutes walk from JR Zushi and take KEIKYU train from Shin Zushi one stop to JIMMUJI Station (train station across Ikego Housing).



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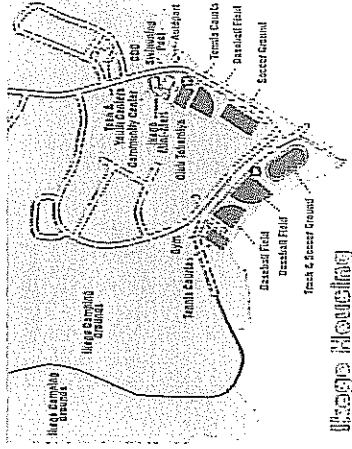
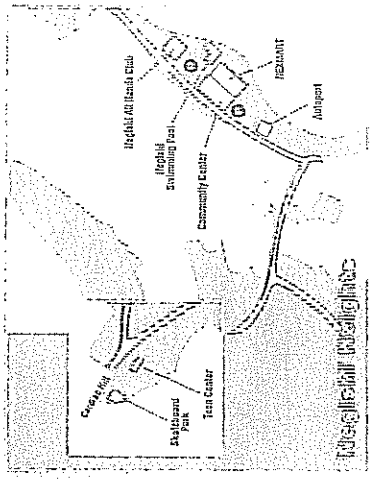
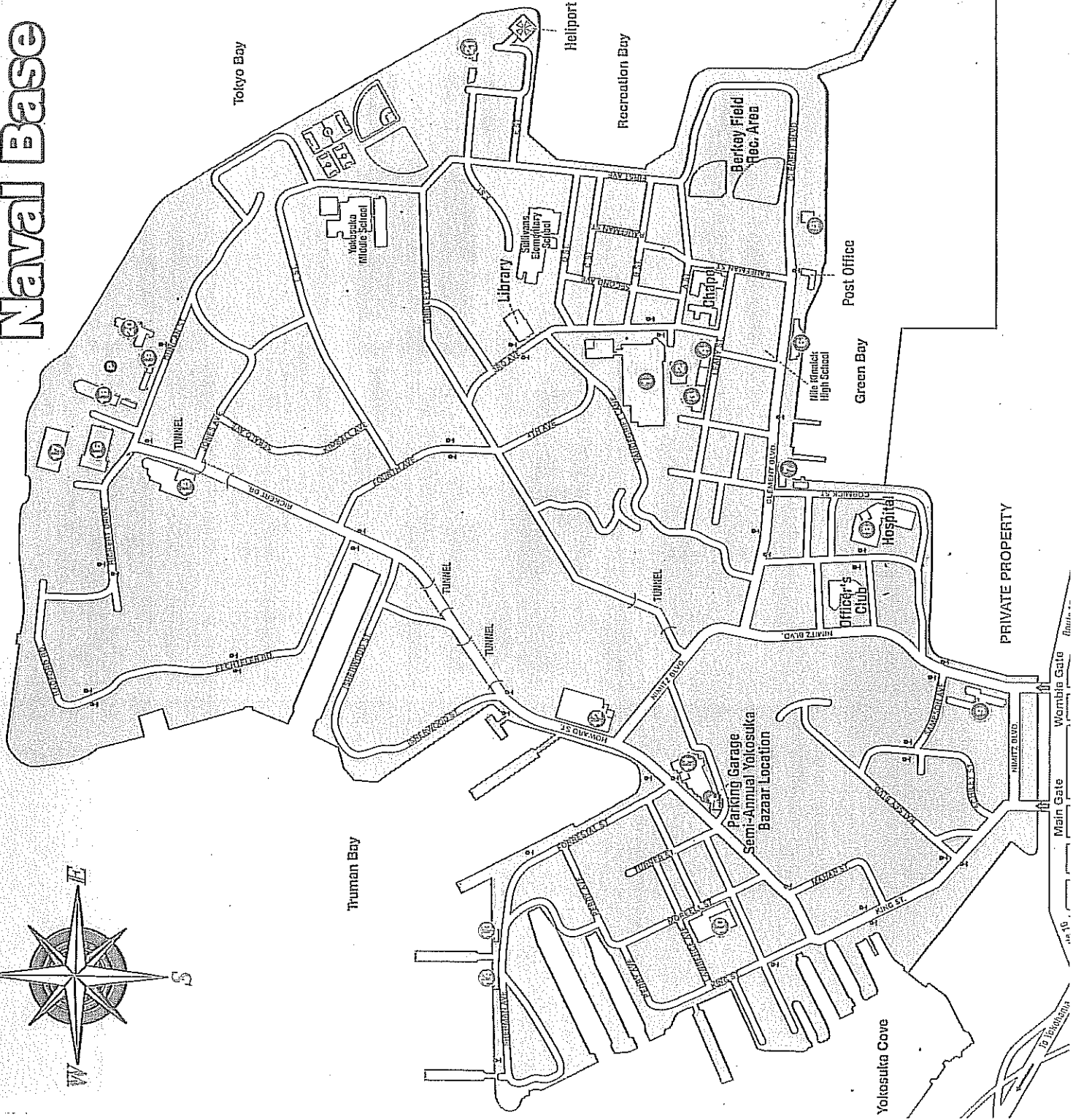
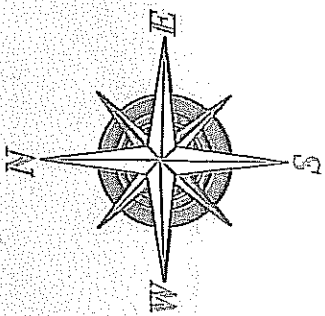

**YOKOSUKA NAVAL COMPLEX
